How to Fill Breezy One

- 1. Press the "Fill" button on the screen and wait for the robot to move into the correct position near the barrel and pump.
- 2. Once in place the robot will display the "Fill Mode" screen (shown below) and you may begin filling the robot with chemical.



- 3. Remove cap from robot tank and insert the pump handle into the tank as far as you are able.
- 4. Turn on pump only to the slower setting (image below) and slowly



begin filling the tank by squeezing the pump handle.

5. You must watch the gauges on the robot screen while filling to determine chemical levels. The pump will not stop itself when full.



- 6. Breezy One will flash green lights and chime to indicate the tank level is full. Do not fill beyond this point.
- 7. Flashing red lights and an alarm chime indicates the robot is over filled and will not operate. Remove chemical from the overfilled tank before using the robot. There is a hand pump for this purpose in every Breezy One spill kit.
